The Aspiring Leadership Course is an active-learning, game-based experience which will introduce you to key concepts of leadership fundamentals.

COURSE OVERVIEW

Research shows that game-based learning is one of the most effective methods for people to absorb and make sense of new concepts. By utilising such an approach our Aspiring Leadership Course gives new leaders a practical toolbox of skills to learn who they are, lead more effectively, and build high performing teams. Set over four fast-moving days of powerful insights, the Course is highly interactive, dynamic and focused on building a solid foundation of basic leadership skills.

Our Aspiring Leadership Course seeks to:

- introduce emerging leaders to the tools required to be a leader, including contemporary and culturally safe practices
- develop participants' skills, knowledge and confidence in building and motivating teams
- encourage aspiring leaders to explore and understand the challenges associated with change and conflict
- develop participants' emotional intelligence, resilience and ability to influence others

LEARNING OUTCOMES

The key outcomes of the Aspiring Leadership Course include (but are not exclusive to):

- identifying and developing personal leadership skills
- building effective teams
- understanding different communication styles and identifying how different people respond to different communication techniques
- understanding emotional intelligence, resilience and perception bias
- identifying personal values
- the impact of change and why people resist change


As the Course is highly interactive, specific topics are developed that are relevant to participants, rather than being generic.
