1. Course Overview

The LeadAbility Course empowers people with disability, or those in the sector, who wish to lead and generate change. Set over 3-months and 7 Experience Days, this dynamic Course develops the leadership skills of participants to become confident and effective leaders.

Carefully designed to be accessible and engaging, participants will experientially learn strong leadership through engaging activities, presentations and workshops with expert speakers. A core aspect of the Course in empowering participants to lead community change are the Community Projects. Divided into small groups, participants are tasked with creating an initiative that could support and improve the lives of people with disability.

2. Learning Outcomes

- Understand personal values and vision
- Learn project scoping and management skills
- Explore learning, thinking and leadership styles
- Understand effective communication
- Develop the ability to work within teams
- Understand co-design and how to implement change
- Identify areas for change to achieve full citizenship

LeadAbility Course graduates join the Leadership WA Community of Practice, a peer support network which provides opportunities for continued learning and collaboration through a regular newsletter, events and networking.
